Berlin High School Tennis and Basketball Courts Replacement

Addendum #2

1. Q: What is the town's intent with the electrical equipment currently secured to the existing fence?
A: **We are disconnecting it and will reconnect once courts are in place.**

2. Q: What is the town's intent with the existing light poles, fixtures, bases and foundations both inside and outside the playing area?
A: **Leave it in place and re-energize at the end of the project. We will paint the poles in the future and change the light lenses.**

3. Q: What is the anticipated start date and completion date?
A: **As Soon As Possible – The Town desires to complete the project this construction season, weather permitting.**

4. Q: RFP states bonds will be required, but does not specify amounts?
A: **A Bid Bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total amount bid is required. Bid Security will be returned to all except the successful bidder upon award, and to the successful bidder upon issuance of a Purchase Order.**

NO BID WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY THE REQUIRED BID BOND.

The awarded contractor shall provide the following bonds in the minimum amounts as specified herein:

Labor and Materials Bond in the amount of 100% of the Total Proposal Price guaranteeing to the Town payments for all labor, materials, and equipment utilized in the completion of work under the Contract in the amount of contract award.

Performance Bond, guaranteed by Surety licensed to do business in Connecticut, in the amount of 100% of the Total Proposal Price guaranteeing to the Town the completion of the Contract.

5. Q: The bid says the owner is supplying the basketball posts and tennis posts. Who is purchasing them?
A: **Contractor is responsible. This should be as turn-key a project as possible.**

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
