IN ORDER FOR VETERANS TO RECEIVE THE ADDITIONAL AND/OR LOCAL OPTION EXEMPTIONS, ONE MUST QUALIFY FOR THE BASIC VETERAN EXEMPTION FIRST.

Veterans' Basic Exemption

Town of Berlin \$1,500 property tax exemption.

Eligibility: Veterans must have served at least ninety (90) days during wartime prior to August 2, 1990. If served after August 2, 1990, service in Persian Gulf not required, nor is service in a combat or combat support role.

Proof: DD-214
Deadline: October 1, 2016

Any Veterans who are new residents or recently discharged that have not filed their DD-214 must do so by October 1, 2016.
Location: Berlin Town Clerk's Office, Rm 19 at Berlin Town Hall.

APPLY ONE-TIME ONLY

Veterans' Additional Exemption

The additional exemption amount depends on the veteran's gross annual income.

If applicants qualify, they will receive an additional exemption equal to twice their basic exemption (which varies if the veteran is disabled). One must meet income requirement to qualify.

Income Limit:
Married applicants: \$42,900
Single applicants: \$35,200
(income must fall below these amounts)

Proof of Income: 2015 SS 1009 Form;
2015 Income Tax Return;
All other proofs of income

Note: Veterans' Disability payments are not considered income for this program.

Deadline: October 1, 2016
Location: Berlin Assessor's Office, Rm 18 at Berlin Town Hall

APPLY EVERY TWO (2) YEARS

Veterans' Local Option

The local option amount depends on the veteran's gross annual income.

The Town of Berlin's Local Option is a \$3,000 exemption.

One must meet income requirement to qualify.

Income Limit:
Married applicants: \$64,500
Single applicants: \$57,300
(income must fall below these amounts)

Proof of Income: 2015 SS 1099 Form;
2015 Income Tax Return;
All other proofs of income

Note: Veterans' Disability payments are considered income for this program.

Deadline: October 1, 2016

Location: Berlin Assessor's Office, Rm 18 at Berlin Town Hall
