

REMINDER: FILING OF DISABILITY RATING AWARD LETTER FROM VETERANS ADMINISTRATION

The law provides for a basic exemption that varies depending on the extent to which a veteran is disabled. (CGS §12-81(20))

Eligibility: Disabled Veteran must have VA Disability Rating Award Letter showing disability rating; Veteran does not have to have served ninety (90) days during wartime

Proof: New applicants must bring their DD-214 along with their VA Disability Certificate Rating Award Letter

Deadline: October 1, 2018

Any veterans who are new residents or new applicants or if disability rating has changed since last filed, must come in with proof.

Location: Berlin Assessor's Office, Rm 18 at Berlin Town Hall

APPLY ONE-TIME ONLY unless rating has changed since last filed

Note: At age 65, filing is no longer required and the disability rating automatically goes to 100%. The Veteran must notify the Assessor's Office when they turn age 65.

| Disability Rating | Amount |
|--------------------------|---------------|
| 10% - 25% | \$1,500 |
| 26% - 50% | \$2,000 |
| 51% - 75% | \$2,500 |
| 76% - 100% | \$3,000 |
