High Road Bridge Replacement Project

The Town of Berlin Public Works Department is planning a project for the replacement of the High Road Bridge. It was constructed in 1958 and during the structure's inspection (performed by the State D.O.T. several years ago), they identified the bridge as being in poor condition. Staff investigated available funding sources, and was successful in being awarded a Local/State Grant whereby 50% of the project would be State funded, and the remaining 50% to be locally funded. The Town's Design Consultant, Cardinal Engineering, reviewed bids for completeness, and recommended that the project be awarded to Martin Laviero Contractor, Inc. in the amount of \$1,034,451.00. Terms and conditions of the project require the work to be completed in 180 calendar days (from about April 15, 2018 to October 1, 2018), which includes closure of the roadway through the bulk of that time-frame. **Please note that High Road will be CLOSED to through traffic between its intersections with Glen Street and Winchell Drive from about April 15, 2018 to October 1, 2018.** Periodic updates will be provided on the Town of Berlin Website.
