<p>Historic District</p> 	<p>5 Regular 3 Alternate</p>	<p>To promote educational, cultural, economic and general welfare of the Town through preservation and protection of historic places and buildings.</p>
<p>Inland/Wetlands & Water Courses</p> 	<p>7 Regular 2 Alternate</p>	<p>To protect the inland wetlands and water courses within the territorial limits of the Town.</p>
<p>Local Emergency Planning Committee</p> 	<p>Consist of several Town Officials</p>	<p>Prepare, maintain and update Town of Berlin hazardous material response plan.</p> <p>Steven Waznia, Fire Marshal (860) 828-7053</p>
<p>Library Board</p> 	<p>9 Regular</p>	<p>In charge of the Library and may expend budgeted sums of money for the operation and maintenance of the Library facility.</p>
<p>Parks & Recreation Commission</p> 	<p>7 Regular</p>	<p>To supervise the use of all public parks and playgrounds, maintain parks and recreation grounds, to provide recreation programs, make recommendations for improvement and acquisition of park areas</p>
<p>Planning & Zoning Commission</p> 	<p>7 Regular 3 Alternate</p>	<p>Reviews and approves land use applications.</p>

<p>Police Commission</p> 	<p>5 Regular</p>	<p>General management and control of the Police Department of the Town and shall make necessary rules and regulations of the government. (Elected Commission)</p>
<p>Public Building Commission</p> 	<p>7 Regular</p>	<p>To develop preliminary plans, cost estimates and supervise the construction of, addition to, or alteration of any building.</p>
<p>VNA Board</p> 	<p>12 Regular</p>	<p>Responsible for providing public health nursing services, visiting nurse services, school health services and other health services.</p>
<p>Town Council</p> 	<p>7 Regular</p>	<p>Governing Board for the Town of Berlin. Elected at large for two year terms.</p>
<p>Veterans Advisory Board</p> 	<p>7 Regular</p>	<p>Address the needs of the Veterans in Town, Memorial Day Parade</p>
<p>Water Control Commission</p> 	<p>5 Regular 3 Alternate</p>	<p>Responsible for the layout, construction and installation, operation and use, maintenance, improvement, extension and discontinuance of all water and sewer systems.</p>
<p>Youth Services Advisory Board</p> 	<p>9 Regular</p>	<p>Studies the condition and needs of our youth in relation to their health, recreation and employment.</p>
<p>Zoning Board of Appeals</p> 	<p>5 Regular 3 Alternate</p>	<p>Hears appeals of the Zoning Regulations.</p>
