

Since the beginning of May there has been an increase in stolen motor vehicles and theft from motor vehicles. These crimes have mostly taken place on the west side of Town (see below). We have increased our patrols in these areas, but we need your help. We are asking residents to be extra vigilant and to call us immediately upon seeing suspicious vehicles, persons, and activity. Also don't forget about the #9pmroutine and these tips:

- ❖ Remove valuables from your vehicle or hide them from view, including garage door openers.
- ❖ Lock car doors and roll windows up.
- ❖ Don't leave vehicles running and unattended (unless you have an automatic starter, of course.)
- ❖ Report any suspicious activity when you see it. Do not wait until later!
- ❖ Leave exterior lights on.
