Berlin Police Chief John Klett is proud to announce that the department will be hosting a Citizen's Police Academy beginning in October 2019. The Citizen's Police Academy affords members of the department an opportunity to positively interact with our community and teach them about what the job entails. We hope to strengthen our relationship with the participants by exchanging ideas and discussing how we strive to meet our goals. In doing so we also hope to reduce any suspicions, fears, or misconceptions they might have about police officers and the Berlin Police Department.

Each week academy participants will have the opportunity to learn about our department by listening to presentations given by police department staff. Presentation topics will include: Criminal Investigations (Major Crime, Fraud, Drug Investigations), Police Operations (Patrol & the Communications Center), Specialized Units (K9, Dive Team, ATV, Bicycle), Traffic Enforcement, Crash Investigation and much more.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Reside or work full-time within the Town of Berlin.
- 21-years of age or older.
- No outstanding warrants or pending criminal cases.
- No felony convictions.
- No misdemeanor arrests within the past three years.

Applications can be found on the Berlin Police Department Website or in person at the Records Department.


