Electronic Community Sign Addendum #2

Q: Providing electrical to the sign is by others or should we include that? The power consumption by an LED display could be much more than the power you currently have to the existing sign.

A: You should include that

Q: Nowhere in the scope does it mention the screen resolution. You will need a minimum of 10mm if you want a display that provides legible graphics, videos and/or small print.

A: See the sample sign example provided in the RFP on page 11. Resolution should be similar to that.

Q: Is the sign intended to be double-sided or visible from both sides?

A: Double sided within 12" of each other per zoning requirement

Q: Included in the bid, I recommend an extended guarantee package which included parts and labor.

A: Include this as an additional option cost

Q: The quality, reliability and LED displays run the gamut from 8-10 years to 1 year or less. My advice to you is basically, beware of low-price products manufactured overseas. The US made products, like Daktronics and Watchfire, are good choices that last. Also, they will provide you with advice on specifying the correct resolution, controls, software and write you a generic specification for bidding process.

A: Daktronics or equivalent
