- Update Back-up radio console and equipment in EOC @ BVFD-
What type of resources are needed at this back up console?

Answer:

The current console is a Motorola computer driven console utilizing CDM1250 radios for transmitting and receiving.

The system back-up communication for Berlin Police, Berlin Fire, Firefighter pager activation tones, DPW and Emergency Management communications over UHF, VHF and 800 frequencies.

The New/upgraded console should replace the hardware and software and all new radios.

According to the list on the RFP UHF interoperability with surrounding towns will not require P25, does this sound correct?

Answer:

No, Rocky Hill is currently using P25.

- Middletown operates 800 MHz P25 Phase 1 & Phase 2 Trunking for interoperability with them, to confirm, this feature is required.
