## ABSENTEE BALLOT APPLICATIONS FOR THE AUGUST 11<sup>TH</sup> PRIMARIES

Active qualified voters should have received an Absentee Ballot Application from the Secretary of the State's Office in the mail. Applications were sent only to active registered Democrats and Republicans, since the application is only for the August primaries. If you plan to vote at your Polling Place, you do not need to complete the application and can discard it.

If you wish to vote by absentee ballot, please complete the application and return it in the self-addressed stamped envelope provided by the Secretary of the State's Office. If you did not receive an application and are registered as a Democrat or Republican, please contact the Town Clerk's Office at 860-828-7036 and we will assist you.

All sections of the application should be completed. This includes Section II as featured below.

- COVID-19 **All voters are able to check this box, pursuant to executive Order 7QQ**
- My active service in the Armed Forces of the United States
- My absence from the town during all of the hours of voting
- My illness
- My religious tenets forbid secular activity on the day of the election, primary or referendum
- My duties as a primary, election or referendum official at a polling place other than my own during all of the hours of voting
- My physical disability

**IMPORTANT** – If you need to have the absentee ballot mailed to a different location, please note your mailing address on the application.
